APPLICATION: ReelRoverTM models 3+1 and 1+1.

REASON FOR RELEASE: To avoid accidents or serious injuries when lifting ReelRoverTM units equipped with the lull-forklift adapter via telehandler, lull, or other types of rough terrain forklifts. Lull forks must only be positioned inside the ReelRoverTM lull forklift adapter pockets. Lifting the ReelRoverTM with lull forks in an incorrect location or manner, other than what is shown below, is extremely dangerous and may result in injury or death.

INCORRECT LIFTING: If the lull forks are positioned anywhere other than within the provided pockets shown below, the ReelRoverTM can slide, shift, become unstable, and fall, which may result in injury or death.

Do not lift from under the lull foklift adapter pockets.



CORRECT LIFTING: Lift all ReelRoverTM models by positioning the forks being utilized inside the appropriately sized forklift pockets, either located at the bottom of the ReelRoverTM frame (orange pockets) or within the lull forklift adapter pockets (black pockets) located below the ReelRoverTM frame, as indicated by the photo above.

URGENCY: Immediate.

LONG TERM RESOLUTION: All attempts to move any ReelRoverTM with a forklift or lull must utilize the provided forklift or lull tubes as shown above.

<u>USER STEPS</u>: Ensure all personnel moving and/or operating the ReelRoverTM are trained and aware of this warning and use the proper method to lift and move the ReelRoverTM. Scan the QR code (right) for ReelRoverTM operating manuals, videos, and resources.



NOTE: All work must be performed by qualified personnel only. Only qualified and OSHA certified forklift operators should attempt to move a ReelRoverTM using a forklift.
